Do not distract your opponent or any other players.



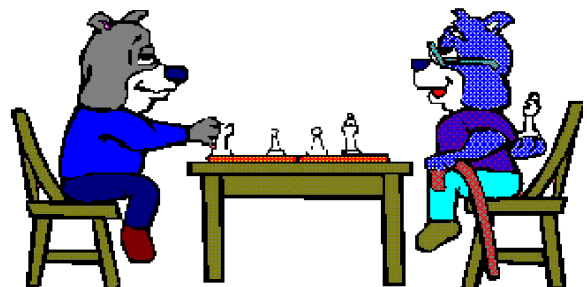
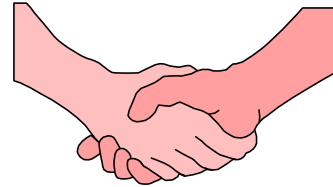
When the game has finished -



Thank your opponent. Do not gloat, show off, get grumpy or feel sad.



Set up or pack up the chess board.



Serious games



While playing or watching a game, do not talk about it or crowd the board.



While playing, between the two handshakes, do not talk or say "Check". (Players are responsible for knowing where everything on the board is and what the threats are.)



Get the arbiter to come if there is a problem.
